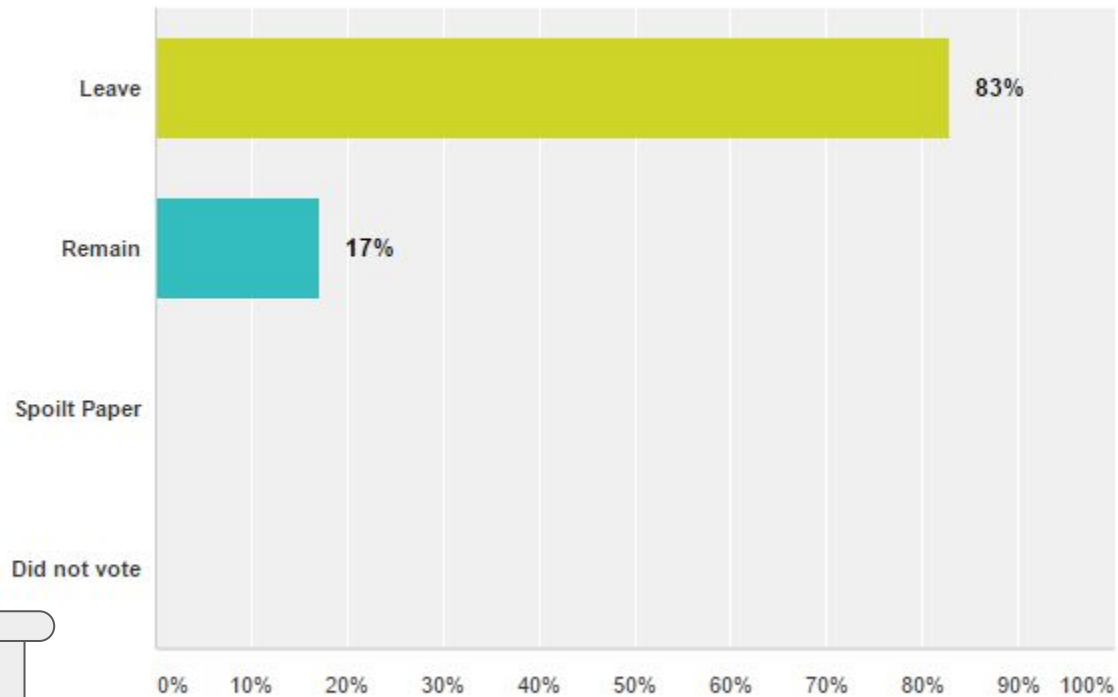




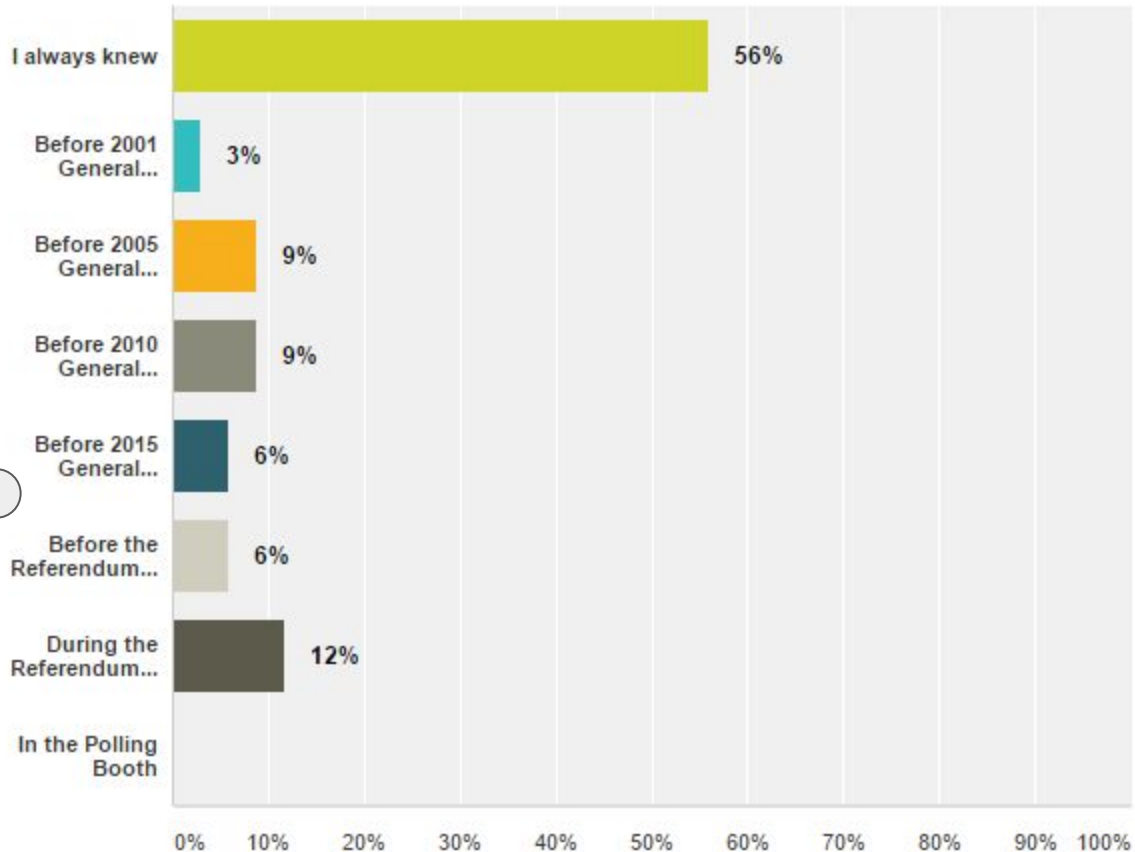
## How did you vote in the EU Referendum?



Most replies were from leavers



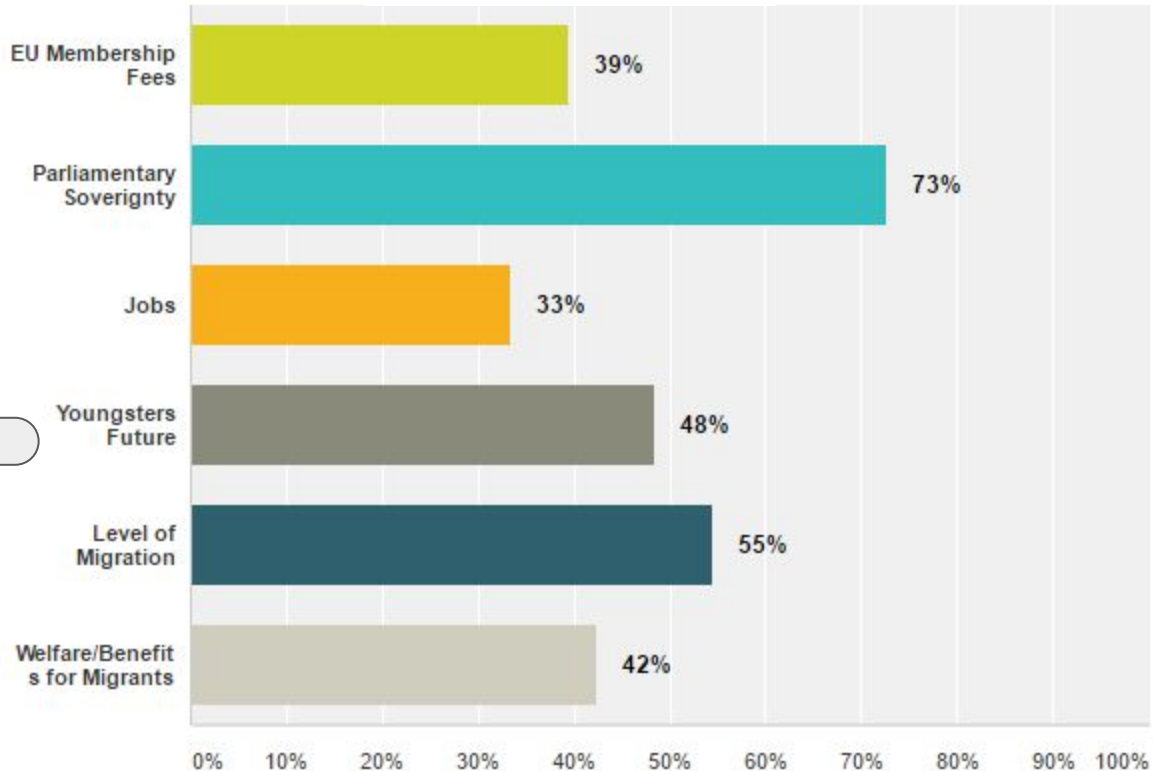
## When did you decide how you would vote?



Most knew how they would vote before the campaign even started.



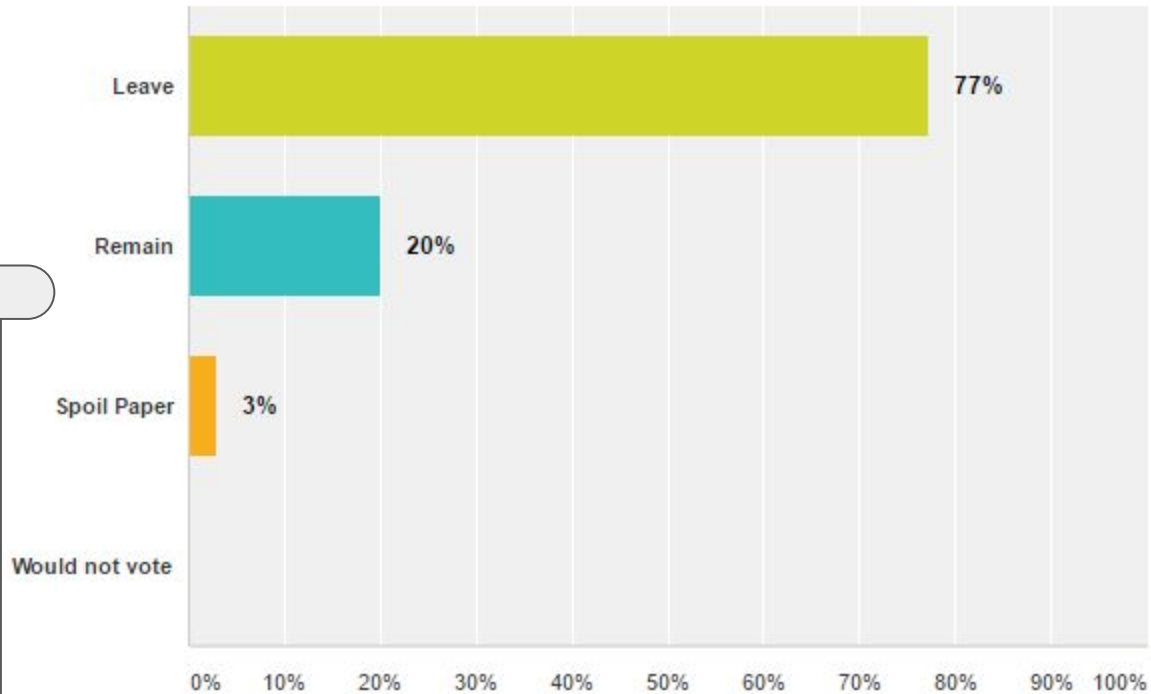
## What issues most persuaded you how to vote? (select 1 or more)

## How would you vote if the EU Referendum was today?

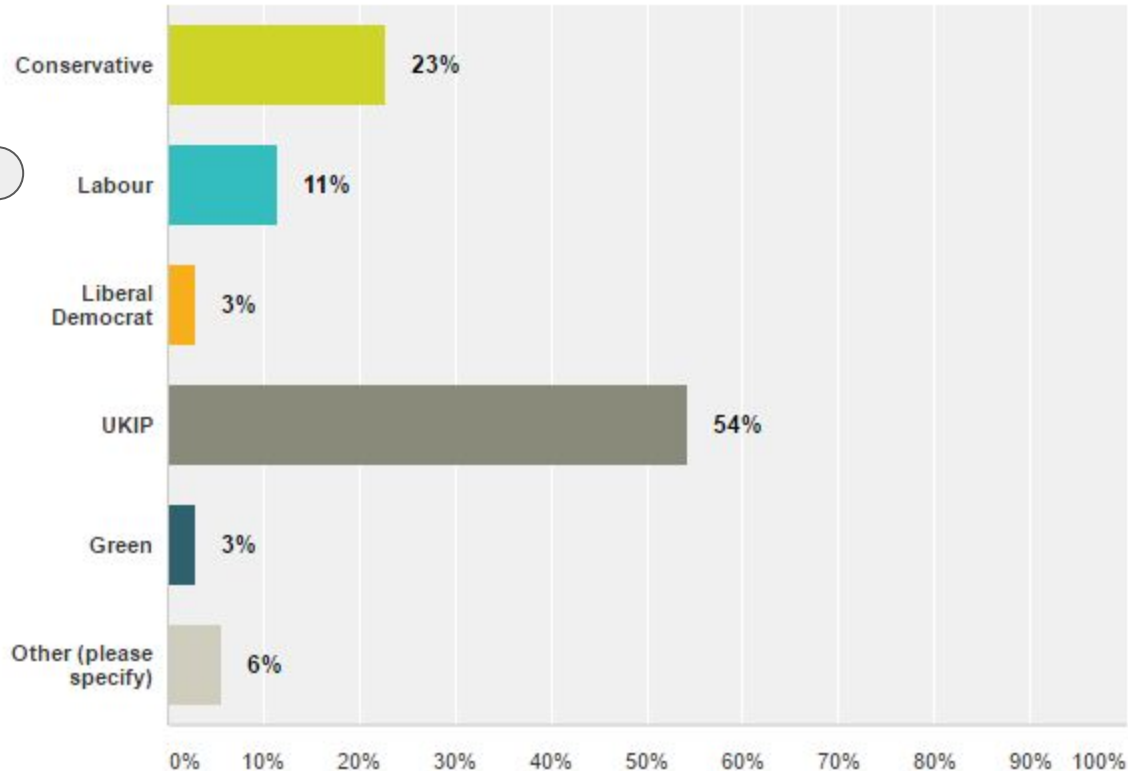


A few claimed to have changed from leave to remain.

## Which party did you vote for in the last General Election?

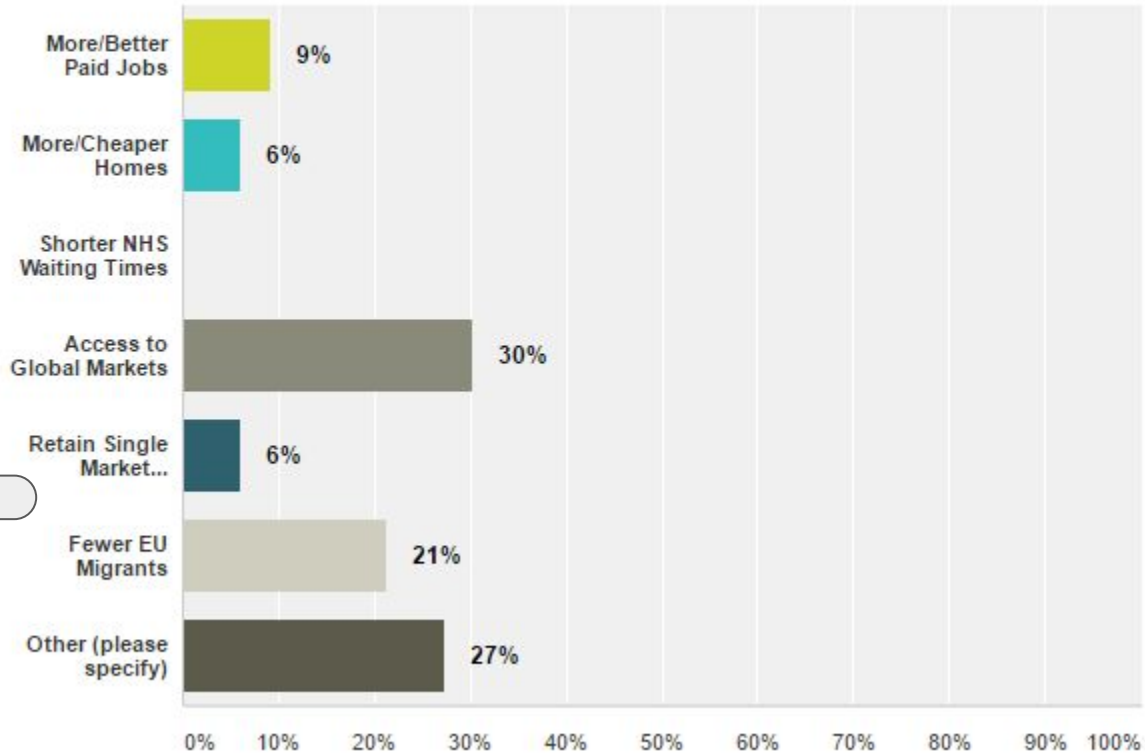


The survey was spread as far and wide as possible, but our audience isn't statistically neutral!

The 'Other' included some who had never bothered to vote before.



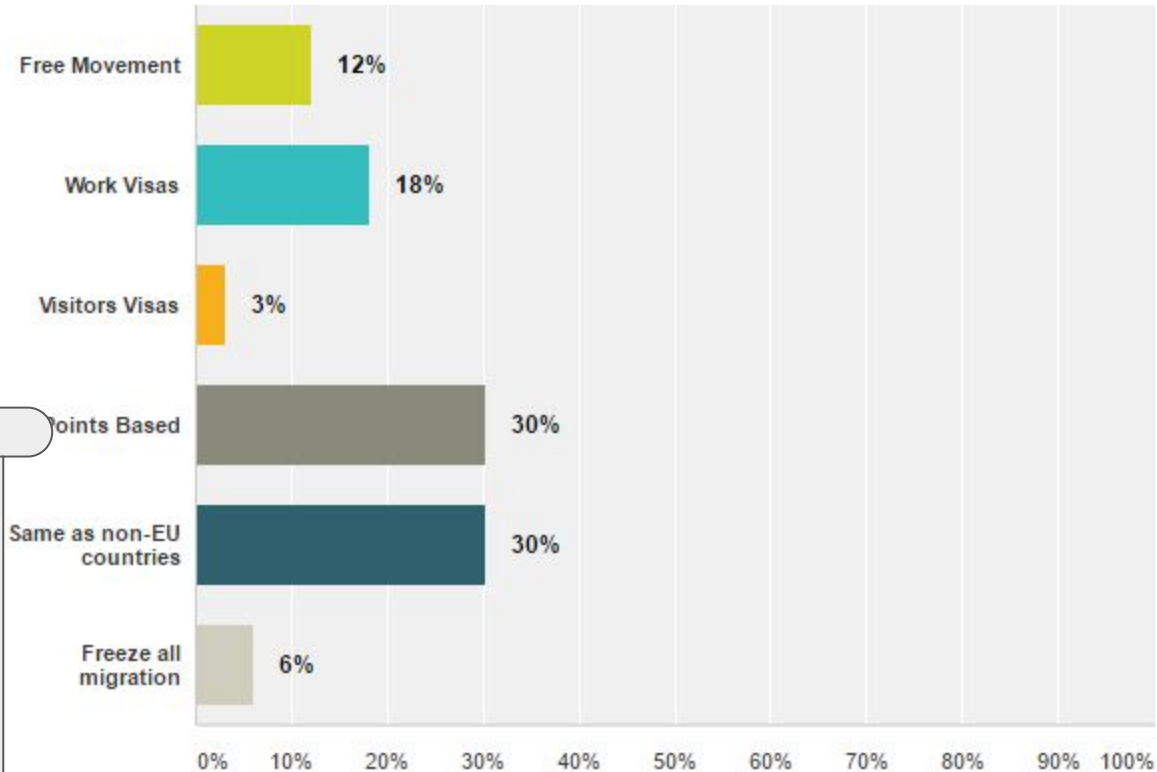
## What do you most want post Brexit



'Other' was mostly people wanting better democracy.



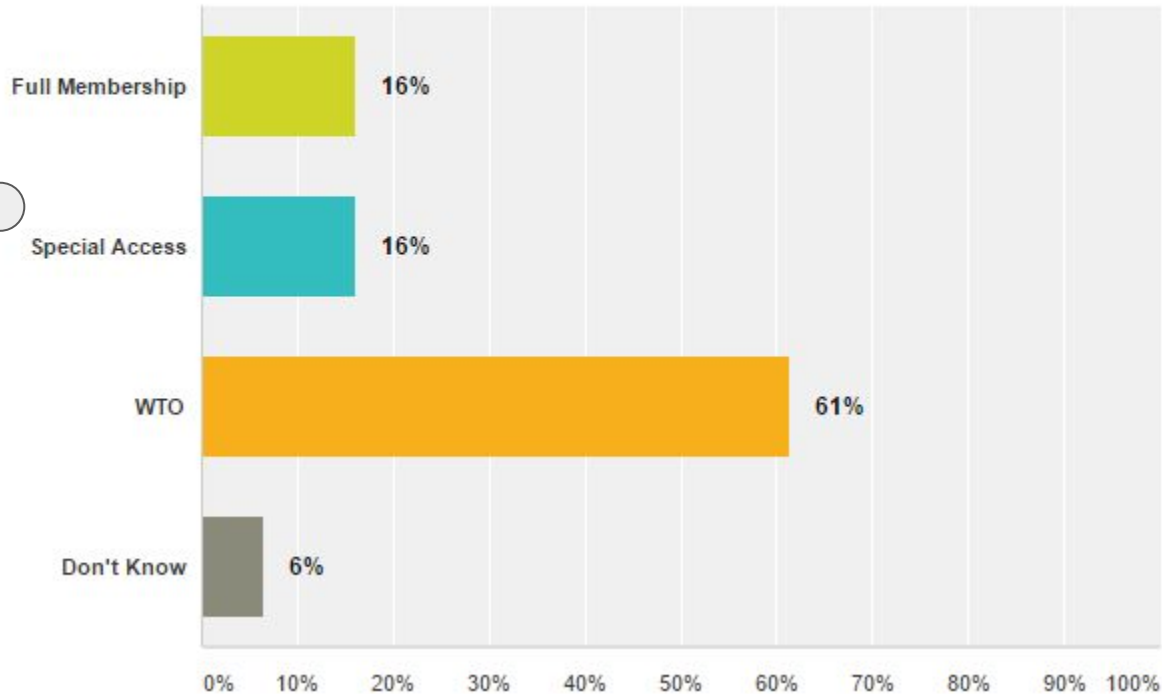
## Borders/Migration, what should UK allow EU citizens?
